## 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF GEORGE LAHEY REPLACED BY GEORGE DALZELL AS KEEPER

2012 marked the 100th anniversary for George Lahey beginning as light keeper, replacing George Dalzell. George T. Dalzell was light keeper from 1893 to 1912. We do not know who the assistant keepers were during his time but hope to research that information in the Grand Manan Archives.

George A. Lahey worked from 1912 to 1934. He also ran a store in North Head while he was keeper, usually spending the night at Swallow Tail and working in his store in the day. His wife ran the store when George was working at Swallow Tail but did come out on occasion. He, of course, was present when any major work needed to be done to the lighthouse, other buildings or walkways. This was possible because of the assistant keepers.

We do not have the name(s) of the assistant keepers for 1912 to 1915 but in 1916, Wallace Lahey worked as assistant keeper, replaced the next year by R.S. Lahey. In 1918 until 1934, Wallace Taylor was assistant keeper, but he too had another job, fishing. His wife Della took up any duties required when Wallace was fishing. Wallace and Della's daughter Betty was born at Swallow Tail and lived there for the first nine years, after which the family moved off. Both George Lahey and Wallace Taylor died the same month in 1951.

Second jobs were common. Light keepers had to supply their own furniture, food and clothing while working at light houses. Wallace Taylor's salary was \$1/day. They often set lobster traps (allowed then) and caught fish or at some remote lighthouses, fishermen would drop off some of their catch in recognition of the service provided by the keepers. The dory for Swallow Tail was used not only for supplies and access but also for fishing, and, on occasion, for children of the keepers to explore.

The Lahey family attended the annual anniversary ceremony on July 7, where we raise the flag with RCMP officers in attendance, and in 2012 had an impromptu concert on the bronze fog bell with Wayne Clifford and MJ Edwards and their dog Millie, John Peacock, and Alexandre Banks. Some of the members of Before the Mast (<http://beforethemastseashanties.com/>) sang following the bell ringing as a prelude to their performance at the Lobster Roll supper that night.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE LAST YEAR

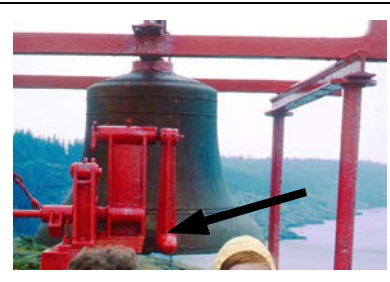
**ARTIST IN RESIDENCE.** The State of Maine and the province of New Brunswick initiated their first artist exchange in 2012. Shoshannah White, an photographer and artist from Portland, ME, approached Laurie to possibly arrange to work with the Grand Manan Whale & Seabird Research Station (GMWSRS) but Laurie suggested that perhaps Swallow Tail might be a better fit given the tight living arrangements at the GMWSRS and the unpredictable research schedules. Shoshannah agreed to be our “test case” for our **Keepers in Residence** program. Shoshannah was able to make many connections on the island, including ones with Portland that she didn’t realized existed. She was able to have a productive three months and in return helped us (see below) and will also be donating prints that we can sell in our gift shop. Shoshannah will be returning to Grand Manan July 20 to August 8 for a show at the Grand Manan Art Gallery. We are not offering our **Keepers** program this summer so we can focus on the restoration work at the lighthouse and finish some work at the keepers house, but we look forward to offering it again in 2014.



**COMMEMORATIVE BENCH.** The Grand Manan graduating class of 1987, installed a commemorative bench overlooking the Swallow Tail peninsula, dedicated to John McKenzie, one of their classmates who died accidentally in 1989 cutting short a life that was full of promise. The log bench has a plaque: **“JOHN WUZ HERE” In loving memory of John MacKenzie 1969-1989. The Class of ‘87.** Many visitors had the pleasure of using the bench and in turn, contemplated who John MacKenzie was. **RESCUED BENCH AND BELL CLAPPER.** One of the wooden lobster trap style benches that was missing was found this summer by a family from Holland who were exploring below the lighthouse and found it in a crevice. Incredibly, the last clapper mechanism for the fog bell was also discovered in the rocks. The bench survived with only minor damage to some of the boards. **INTERNATIONAL LIGHTHOUSE & LIGHTSHIP WEEKEND.** Rick MacMillan, Sterling Carpenter, and Art Gunn set up in the keepers house for the International Lighthouse & Lightship Weekend in August, 2012, using their ham radios to communicate with other lighthouses around the world.



**STORM WINDOWS.** Not many people would get excited about them but at the keepers house we were very happy. Storm windows are crucial to single pane wooden windows, particularly when the weather is as extreme as it can be at Swallow Tail. We kept the wooden single pane windows to maintain the historic character of the house. We had salvaged as many original storms as we could but many were missing so we had the remainder fabricated in Ontario at Schnell Lumber by an octogenarian. He had also made the windows for the boathouse. There are only a few people that still make single pane wooden windows. The windows helped to quiet the interior, especially when the fog horn was blowing and kept the driving rain and snow from coming in the house. They are hinged so they can be opened. **INTERIOR PAINTING.** We have been slowly working on the interior and now that the storm windows are in place and the chimneys repaired, we don’t have to worry about the water damage that had been occurring inside the keepers house. Shoshannah White, our first artist in residence, worked many Thursdays in September and October, to sand and prime most of the rooms.

She was joined by some of our dedicated volunteers and also Marie-Hélène Tabah, visiting from Quebec, and Brynn & Shandor, new residents to Grand Manan, who arrived by boat. The next step is to get the historic colours from 1958 onto the walls.

**US LIGHTHOUSE SOCIETY VISIT AND PASSPORT PROGRAM.** In late September, 2012, a group from the U.S. Lighthouse Society visited Grand Manan Island. They toured the lighthouses in the area by land and by boat. Many had “passports” that are stamped at every participating lighthouse they have visited. The Society offered to add Swallow Tail to their list of lighthouses and provide our own stamp for no cost. They have two other Canadian sites—Campobello Island (East Quoddy and Mulholland Point) and Victoria, BC (Fisgard Light). Our stamp and some passports will be at the Welcome Centre this summer. Passports are \$15 and it is suggested that holders leave a small donation (\$1.00) at each participating lighthouse when they get their passports stamped. The have also begun to include museums who have significant lighthouse artefacts such as a Fresnel lens. The Grand Manan Museum fits this category and is also now part of this network. **INCREDIBLE SNOW STORM.** Winter storms were frequent with one particularly storm, exceeding all others. On February 9, hurricane force northeast winds buffeted the island, coupled with extremely high tides, storm surges, and below freezing temperatures, which created localized flooding over seawalls, thick coating of sea ice where waves crashed onto land and abundant tree damage. The strength of the wind and the weight of the ice was too much for many trees in the brunt of the storm. Unlike many of our storms which see temperatures rising and snow turning to rain, we only received snow. 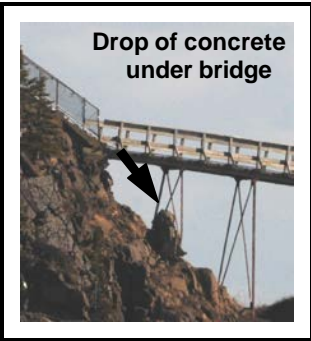
**DAMAGE TO THE CONCRETE SUPPORTS.** Rebuilt in 1966, the footbridge and stairs providing access to Swallow Tail have seen all types of weather. The bridge spans very fragmented rock which over time eroded away under a concrete support at the base of the stairs and beginning of the bridge. This came tumbling down in late January leaving the bridge unsupported at one end. We were forced to restrict access to the peninsula because of the safety concerns. Once the engineering report was completed, we had to remove the concrete block that wedged against one of the support legs. By using a jack hammer and hydraulic jack, the block continued its journey downward and is now part of the boulders at the water level. Rebar, concrete and metal cross pieces restored the safety of the footbridge in late May. Thanks to the Village of Grand Manan for looking after the costs for this necessary work and we are very sorry for those who could not walk out to the lighthouse during the closure.

**LIGHTHOUSE.** Swallow Tail lighthouse is now owned by the Village of Grand Manan with the Canadian Coast Guard retaining ownership of the navigation equipment (fog horn and detector, light, generator, etc.). Swallow Tail will continue to be an active lighthouse. We have changed our lease with the Village to incorporate all of the property which will be in effect until 2033, when we can opt to renew. Before the transfer, the Village had a lease with the federal government so we could make some repairs to the lighthouse to stop some of the water penetration. We were also able to make an assessment of the magnitude of the work involved in the restoration. We have proposals submitted to provincial and federal agencies, and are hoping that we are successful in obtaining the necessary funds to have the lighthouse open as a working museum in 2014. As part of our fund-raising this year, Tidal Threads, a local quilting group, is making a beautiful quilt entitled “Fog Bound”. Raffle tickets will be available throughout the summer and fall.



**WELCOME CENTRE & GIFT SHOP:** The provincial SEED program and the federal Summer Placement program both funded eight weeks for two student for our Welcome Centre, the building moved in the 1960s from the decommissioned Ross Island lighthouse. Thanks to students Courtney Guptill and Jesse Gagne, and volunteers who helped set up or worked in the fall including Linda L’Aventure, Carol Green, Frances Hodge, Ken Ingersoll, Mary

McClintock, Laurie Murison, and Alexis Phillips. Over 6,100 people visited during July and August during business hours (10am—6pm) with some taking home t-shirts, cotton bags, buttons, postcards, historic prints, etc. We also had a collection of knitted items donated for resale.
